PATIENT IV CONTRAST ALERT AND FOLLOW UP FORM

You received iodinated intravenous contrast or “x-ray dye” (reduced dose) for CT today _____ (date), at _____ (time) and based on your kidney function tests, you may be at increased risk for kidney problems (contrast induced nephropathy).

The following are recommended:

1. Avoid dehydration/volume depletion.
2. Oral or IV hydration (at the direction of your referring healthcare provider).
3. Repeat IV contrast administration should be avoided. If a repeat exam is necessary, your healthcare provider should discuss it with Nephrology.
4. Follow up with your healthcare provider regarding your renal function.
